Item 1:

Call meeting to order - Chairman Jacques called the meeting to order

Item 2:

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance – Chairman Jacques led the invocation and pledge of allegiance to the American flag.

Item 3:

Item 4: Public Comment:

a. Phillip Flattley - 2091 Burnette RD - Red Hill - Brief overview of development of Impact Fees in the State of Georgia - in the 80s Gov Joe Frank Harris sought to regulate local governments - the Georgia Development Impact Act was enacted - local governments control certain departments. Mr. Flattley provided an exhaustive report. Local governments are required to follow an exhaustive process, including Comprehensive Plan. Mr. Flattley described the functions, restrictions and other aspects of this process; he exhausted the 5-minute speaking limit. Chairman Jacques thanked Mr. Flattley for the report and written backup materials.
