### Item 5. Public Comment

Amy Hanley– spoke regarding she had reviewed the IBA minutes from February and noticed that Commissioner Smith had asked questions at the meeting. Hanley stated she had asked questions: To what end are we spending money to change a record that is four years old? How much citizens money is being spent? She asked Commissioner Smith if he received answers to his questions. Commissioner Smith said he hasn't received answers to the questions. Ms. Hanley then asked Commissioner Foster if he could answer the questions. Foster said he hasn't received an update since the meeting. Hanley asked who oversees the IBA and are they under the umbrella of the BOC? Chairman Jacques said the only thing the BOC does is negotiates any SPLOST allocations and the annual millage rate allocation to their budget is approved which historically has been a quarter of a mill. We are well aware of the issues between the IBA and the constitutional officer and have offered to mediate/arbitrate a solution between both entities to bring about the most expeditious resolution possible. Hanley asked is there any oversite fiscally to the IBA? Chairman Jacques said there is annualized audit done independently by an auditor.

There is an IGA with the Franklin County Board of Education and they are paying these costs; the county is looking after the project for them. John Phillips, County Engineer recommends the low bid from Dale Construction Company in the amount of \$250,377.00

### I. Legacy Link – Addendum No. 1 to Agreement – Recommendation

Chairman Jacques said the addendum will enhance their ability as a grant oversite entity. They will be increasing the number of nutritional services to elderly citizens in the county and home delivered nutrition services to the elderly. This is an addendum to the original contract from July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024. ### J. Radio System – Recommendation

Terry Harris – It has been a long process in coming to the decision to replace the radio system in Franklin County. After much discussion and research our recommendation is to go with CI-Communications International for the P25 Public Safety Radio System at a cost of \$7,633,881.42. This is an 18-month process and CI has agreed to come in at no cost to upgrade the old system to keep it functional until the upgrade is complete.

Chairman Jacques stated: Since the resignation of Mr. Turner our former county manager, Mr. Harris has been serving as Interim County Manager. It is now time for the board to move forward with finalization of the county manager position. <u>Chairman Jacques asked the board for a motion to approve, deny, and/or table.</u> <u>Motion to Approve</u>: Commissioner Smith made a motion to approve the contract and appoint Terry Harris as County Manager. <u>Motion Seconded</u>: Commissioner Busby <u>Discussion</u>: None All in favor vote: motion carried 5-0 (approved)
